DISASTER RENEWAL PERIOD EXCEPTION FORM

Businesses that meet the following conditions may file a renewal application more than 30 days past the expiration of their license/permit and avoid a late fee:

- The license/permit expired seven days prior to a disaster or up to 30 days after a qualifying disaster.
- The failure to timely renew must have been reasonable under the circumstances (e.g., occurred as a direct result of the current coronavirus pandemic).
- You have not already filed an original license/permit application or a renewal application to replace your expired license/permit.
