**ORDER**

**CAME ON FOR CONSIDERATION** this 15<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2002, the above-styled and numbered cause.

After proper notice was given, this case was heard by Administrative Law Judge Louis Lopez. The hearing convened on October 29, 2001, and adjourned the same day. The Administrative Law Judge made and filed a Proposal For Decision containing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law on December 10, 2001. This Proposal For Decision was properly served on all parties who were given an opportunity to file Exceptions and Replies as part of the record herein. As of this date no exceptions have been filed.

The Assistant Administrator of the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission, after review and due consideration of the Proposal for Decision, Transcripts, and Exhibits, adopts the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law of the Administrative Law Judge, which are contained in the Proposal For Decision and incorporates those Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law into this Order, as if such were fully set out and separately stated herein. All Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, submitted by any party, which are not specifically adopted herein are denied.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED**, by the Assistant Administrator of the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission, pursuant to Subchapter B of Chapter 5 of the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Code and 16 TAC §31.1, of the Commission Rules, that Permit Nos. MB-415283 and LB-415284 are hereby **SUSPENDED**.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that unless the Respondent pays a civil penalty in the amount of \$70,000.00 on or before the 20<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2002, all rights and privileges under the above described permits will be **SUSPENDED for a period of one hundred and forty (140) days, beginning at 12:01 A.M. on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2002.**

**This Order will become final and enforceable on February 5, 2002**, unless a Motion for Rehearing is filed **before** that date.
